

# Bleeding & Bandaging Skills

1. Steps in bleeding control.
  - a. BSI, Scene safety..... **INTRODUCTIONS.**
  - b. Direct pressure.
  - c. Elevation (assure no other injury to area being elevated).
  - d. Dress wound.
  - e. If bleed through go to pressure dressing.
  - f. Tourniquet. Mark the forehead.
2. Hand / fingers.
3. Wrist.
4. Forearm.
5. Elbow / bend of elbow area.
6. Upper arm.
7. Shoulder.
8. Arm pit.
9. Sling & swathe.
10. Toes / Foot.
11. Ankle.
12. Lower leg.
13. Knee area.
14. Thigh region.
15. Hip.
16. Buttock.
17. Chest laceration (not a sucking chest wound).
18. Penetrating wound to the chest (sucking chest wound).
19. Abdominal laceration (not an evisceration).
20. Abdominal evisceration.
  - a. Leg positioning.
21. Impaled objects – everywhere.
  - a. Abdominal management / leg positioning.
22. Impaled object in the eye using a cup and donut roll.
23. Neck laceration with jugular vein involvement.
  - a. Occlusive dressing / figure 8.
24. Amputation management.
25. Tourniquet application – rare circumstance and may ultimately require amputation.
